Jennifer received an After Dark award for outstanding performance and a Theatre World award for outstanding off-Broadway debut for her work as Emily Webb, and after 702 performances, she has played the role more times than anyone else in history. In 2010, she co-created a mock horror radio play series called *HORRORGASM*, for which she writes, directs, produces, edits and does voice work.
